Answers to the questions below include draft FY 08-09 data that is under review for publication

1. How much is held statewide by redevelopment agencies in their Low & Moderate Fund?

Draft figures for end of FY 08-09 show:

- \$5.1 billion (b) as Total Fund Equity (funds and assets excluding all liabilities)
- \$3.2 b as Net Resources Available (fund equity minus total assets (\$1.9b) not yet available)
- \$1.3 b as "available" funds (Net Resources Available minus both funds encumbered (\$.7b) and designated (\$1.2 b) for expenditure over next fiscal year)
- 2. On average how long does it take for redevelopment agencies to spend their Low & Moderate Fund?

Agencies spend their funds differently over each project area's life of 40+ years.

3. How many units have been built using Low & Moderate Funds statewide (only during the period when HCD has been receiving reports)? Provide if possible based on income -- very, low, moderate - income?

While Agencies have been reporting to HCD since 1984, we only have electronic data since 1999. The Department could provide data for prior years, but it would take some time to compile.

4. Can you compare how many units have been built with Proposition 46 and Proposition 1C funds verses Low & Moderate Funds?

This answer cannot be readily provided. Most assisted housing projects include multiple funding sources. Many include both Low & Moderate funds and Proposition 46 or 1C bond funds. HCD's database does not allow for ready identification of HCD projects with Low & Moderate funds, however while it would take time, the Department could manually research the question.
